Yemen Salt Pans

Come & Discover 'Les Salines de Yemen' which is a small salt farm situated at the entrance of Tamarin in the South West of Mauritius, constructed during the French Period. More than 100 years old, these buildings & these traditions mesmerize Mauritians & tourists who want to preserve the salt works.

Indeed, from generations to generations, sea salt has been harvested in a homemade and traditional way, in collaboration with the families of the village. Do not miss this chance to visit this beautiful site, where you can also find some souvenirs in the shop. Moreover, the Tamarin salt works is one of the most emblematic places in the Mauritian landscape. Which is a symbol of the country's authenticity and cultural richness. Le Morne UNESCO World Heritage Site

Le Morne Cultural Landscape, a rugged mountain that juts into the Indian Ocean in the southwest of Mauritius was used as a shelter by runaway slaves, maroons, through the 18th and early years of the 19th centuries. Protected by the mountain's isolated, wooded and almost inaccessible cliffs, the escaped slaves formed small settlements in the caves and on the summit of Le Morne. The oral traditions associated with the maroons, have made Le

Morne a symbol of the slaves' fight for freedom, their suffering, and their sacrifice, all of which have relevance to the countries from which the slaves came -the African mainland, Madagascar, India, and South-east Asia. Indeed, Mauritius, an important stopover in the eastern slave trade, also came to be known as the "Maroon republic" because of the large number of escaped slaves who lived on Le Morne Mountain.

Macondé

Macondé is located in the south west of Mauritius, between Le Morne and Baie du Cap and the name originates after the governor Jean Baptiste Henri Condé who had build an outlook on the rock long time ago. Today Macondé, together with the surrounding coastal roads, is a very scenic place where you will enjoy the breath taking views by climbing up the narrow stairs to the district boundary marker dating from 1878.

Black River Gorges

Visit of the capital, Port Louis

Enjoy the beautiful greenery around MARIE REINE DE LA PAIX

Marie Reine de la Paix is an open catholic church on the side of Signal mountain, with beautiful panoramic view of the city, Port-Louis. It is a very popular spot visited daily by many locals and tourists for prayers as well as to enjoy the amazing green scenery. Climbing about 82 steps leads up to the monument.

Once at the top, allow yourself to relax and take in the absolutely gorgeous scenery. The amazing gardens surrounding the church is a real beauty with patches of flowers of different colors.

Visit of LA CITADELLE

La Citadelle, also known as Fort Adelaide, is among the places not to miss in Port Louis. Located at the top of a hill named 'La Petite Montagne', La Citadelle is a picturesque fortification built up under the British colonisation to provide for those in control with a strategic 360-degree

Visit THE CAUDAN WATERFRONT, a modern and elegant shopping centre

The Caudan Waterfront is unique shopping mall which combines a modern architectural design with a rich historical background. Le Caudan Waterfront is a must for shopping offering the best shopping experience with a great selection ranging from accessories such as jeweleries, watches; souvenirs and crafts, body care, clothing for men, women, children along with beach wear and sports wear, stationery and books among many others. Enjoy a trip through the buzzing CENTRAL MARKET OF PORT LOUIS

It is a very energetic market with stalls piled high with tropical fruits and vegetables and also a large array of spices and herbal medicines. The meat, fish and sea food are in a separate section of the market. Discover the food court of the market where you can choose from a variety of local snacks and foods such as dhol puri, bryani, and the typical Mauritian refreshing drink *Alouda* among many others. Many local souvenirs and handicrafts are also available, along with t-shirts and others fabrics.

Visit of AAPRAVASI GHAT which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site

Located in Port-Louis, Aapravasi Ghat was the first immigration office in Mauritius and covers an area of 1,640 m². Built in 1849 by the British government, Aapravasi Ghat is a historical site through which nearly half a million immigrants from India, Eastern Africa, Madagascar, China and Southeast Asia transited, from 1849 to 1920, to work in sugar plantations as indentured labourers. Nearly 70% of Mauritians can trace their roots back to Aapravasi Ghat. Some of the original stone buildings can still be found on the site and there are strategically placed life-sized models of the immigrants. The site was listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2006 for its crucial role in the island's social history.

Visit of HINDU TEMPLE

Being a multicultural island, our population is made up of multiple religions, races and cultures living in harmony together. Further to this, there are a number of places of worship around the island which also include Hindu temples. Discover the beautiful Dravidian architecture during your visit of one of the Hindu temples. You will be amazed at its traditional decorations all meticulously handcrafted by Indian artists. The colourful sculptures representing Hindu deities are arranged to portray mythological scenes.
