#### WHERE IS CAMP KALAHARI

20°28'3.59"S 25° 8'0.39"E

You'll find Camp Kalahari amongst the acacias and mokolwane palms of Brown Hyena Island, on the edge of Botswana's hauntingly beautiful Makgadikgadi Salt Pans. Wildlife in the surrounding savannah includes brown hyena, bat-eared foxes, elephant (the camp swimming pool is a welcome stop!), meerkat and during the green season, spectacular numbers of zebra and wildebeest.

#### WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Camp Kalahari is open all year round.

Please note that some activities are seasonally dependent.

**Dry season:** 16 April – 31 October

**Green season:** 01 November – 15 April

#### HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights from Cape Town and Johannesburg to Maun and then take a small charter plane to the Makgadikgadi. Road and self-drive transfers from Maun (approx. 4-5 hrs) are also possible.

#### WHERE WILL I STAY

12 spacious Meru tents - 6 twins, 4 doubles and 2 family tents (1 king size bed & 2 single beds.) All are ensuite with indoor showers, outfitted with standing fans, rich textiles and four poster beds.

#### WHAT WILL I EAT

Camp Kalahari has a reputation for delicious, fresh and original food. Meals are plated, not buffet style. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

#### FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

All meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

#### WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

Camp Kalahari is refreshingly simple, cosy, comfortable and traditional. Guests can relax in a traditionally-built thatch library, living and dining area, and when it heats up, cool off in the large swimming pool.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- We welcome children of all ages (please refer to our rates for child policies).
- There are lanterns as well as electrical lights in the guest tents and dining area.
- Camera charging facilities are available in the mess tent (please bring an adaptor).
- There is no Wifi or phone signal in camp.
- Our vehicles are open and fit a maximum of 7 people.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 28 guests in camp.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.
- If quad biking, please bring a good pair of sunglasses or goggles - the sunlight and dust can be harsh.



#### WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

##### Year Round:

- Meet the habituated meerkats.
  - Walks with the Zu/hoasi Bushmen.
  - Game drives and night drives.
  - Search for the elusive brown hyena.
  - Visit the site of Chapman's Baobab.
  - Helicopter flips.\*
  - Morning and afternoon horse rides.\*
- \*Subject to a surcharge

##### Dry Season (April – October):

- Lie out on the pans at sun set and watch the planetarium show unfold.
- Quad biking. (2 guests per quad bike, weather dependent).

##### Green Season (November – April):

- Witness the zebra and wildebeest migration, the second largest in Africa.

#### WHERE IS MENO A KWENA

20° 19' 24.51" S 24° 19' 6.99" E

Located on the western boundary of Makgadikgadi Pans National Park (MPNP), Meno is situated on tribal land overlooking the exceptionally scenic Boteti River, which has been flowing since 2008. The camp is easily accessible from Maun - just a 90 minute drive.

#### WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Meno a Kwena is open all year round. The zebra congregate at the river during the dry season (but this cannot be guaranteed!) and game viewing is excellent in all seasons. The below is rough guide to the seasons, but in April/May and October/November, the weather is variable.

**Dry season:** April – October

**Green season:** November – March

#### HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights to Maun from Cape Town and Johannesburg. Transfers by road from Maun to Meno depart btw 14h00 - 15h00 (to allow for delays). The drive takes 90 minutes on good tarred roads, with 5 kms on a gravel road. Self-drive options also available. Alternatively, fly from Maun to Motopi airstrip, a 30 minute drive to Meno.

#### WHERE WILL I STAY

There are 10 tents - 2 doubles (king size bed), 6 twins (2 queen size beds) and 2 family tents (1 family unit has 1 x King-size bed & 3 x singles, the other has 1 x King-size bed and 2 x 3/4 beds), all ensuite with indoor and outdoor showers. Tents have standing fans and are solar powered with lighting and international charging plugs. All look straight down to the Boteti River.

#### WHAT WILL I EAT

The chefs at Meno a Kwena create good, wholesome food and all meals are prepared on an open fire. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

#### FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

All meals, daily activities (incl the sleepout in a 3-night stay; must be pre-booked), local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature, transfers from Maun and personal travel insurance are excluded.

#### WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The canvas lounge and dining tents are piled high with books, trinkets and artefacts, adding to the old-world feeling of the camp. There is a bar, library, refreshing, clifftop swimming pool and a floating hide.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- We welcome children of all ages (please refer to our rates for child policies).
- Limited wifi is available in camp.
- Charging facilities available in rooms and main area.
- Our vehicles are open and accommodate 8 guests.
- The camp accommodates a maximum of 22 guests.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.



#### WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

##### Year Round:

- Full day and half day game drives into Makgadikgadi Pans National Park.
- Cultural walks with the Kalahari Bushmen.
- Game viewing hide.
- Fat Bikes. 12 yrs & up. Max 4 guests. Weather & fitness dependant.
- Visits to the local communities. On request.

##### Green Season:

- Day trips to Nxai Pan. On request.

##### Dry Season:

- Boating on the Boteti. Aug - Dec. Always water dependent.
- Zebra migration. Jun - Nov. Always weather dependent.

##### Sleep-out:

- Sleep-out under the stars on the Pans. NB: this requires a minimum 3-night stay with a minimum of 2 guests. The sleepout can be done from 01 May to 30 September only and is subject to weather and dryness of the pans. Must be pre-booked.





A JOINT VENTURE WITH THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, SABLE ALLEY IS A LIGHT, BRIGHT AND BEAUTIFULLY SOPHISTICATED CAMP AMID THE GAME-RICH FLOODPLAINS OF KHWAI PRIVATE RESERVE.

#### WHERE IS SABLE ALLEY

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Sable Alley is located in the 200,000 hectare Khwai Private Reserve concession, overlooking vast floodplains. Red lechwe, waterbuck and reedbuck along with many antelope species are full time residents, whilst sightings of lion, leopard, spotted hyena and wild dog are excellent. Elephants abound and very quickly become an all-time favourite.

#### WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Sable Alley is open all year round with excellent game viewing. Water levels are highest in April to October for exploring on mokoros and boats. At other times of year, water activities may be restricted.

**Dry season:** April – October

**Green season:** November – March

#### HOW DO I GET THERE

Direct flights are available to Maun from Cape Town and Johannesburg. Fly to Maun and then switch to a light aircraft to fly to our airstrip in the Khwai Reserve. Road transfers from Maun and self-drive options are available – please contact us for details.

#### WHERE WILL I STAY

There are 10 twin/double tents and 2 family tents with 1 double and 2 single beds, all have ceiling fans and are ensuite with indoor and outdoor showers. Tents are raised on decks with a private veranda.

#### WHAT WILL I EAT

Our wonderful chefs have a reputation for their good, wholesome meals. Please let us know of any dietary requirements prior to arrival.

#### FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

All meals, daily activities, local drinks and laundry are included. Flights, premium brand beverages, discretionary tips/gratuities, items of a personal nature and personal travel insurance are excluded.

#### WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The enormous main area boasts a lounge, several cosy seating areas, a bar, fire pit and swimming pool, all with views of the lagoon ahead. The camp is solar-powered.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- We welcome children 6 yrs and older, *(please refer to our rates for child policies).*
- Wifi is available in camp.
- Charging facilities are available in the rooms and main area.
- Our vehicles are open and accommodate 7 guests.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 28 guests in camp.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.

**NOTE:** In 2019, road transfers to Skybeds will be charged at an extra per person rate.



#### WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

##### Year Round:

- Morning & afternoon game drives.
- Mokoro safaris *(water-level dependent).*
- Walking safaris.

##### Dry Season:

- Boating safaris *(water-level dependent).*
  - Sleep out under the stars at Skybeds. *Must be pre-booked.*
- Children 15 yrs and older are welcome.*  
*Open 1 April - 31 October.*
